

necessary. The President also shall call a meeting upon request of not less than seven (7) members of the Board of Trustees.

C. The Officers and Board of Trustees shall have quarterly meetings through out the fiscal year at a location so designated by the President of this association.

## **ARTICLE 7**

### **AMENDMENTS**

The constitution and by-laws of this association may be changed and/or amended by a vote of two thirds (2/3) of the members in good standing of this association who are present and vote on the issue at the annual meeting of the association. Any proposed change in the constitution and by-laws shall be mailed to each active member of the association not less than thirty (30) days prior to the next annual meeting. Said notices shall be performed by and at the expense of the proponent of said change or amendment, except when the said changes or amendments are proposed by not less than two thirds (2/3) of the members of the Board of Trustees, the notices and mailings shall be performed by the secretary at the expense of the association.

## **ARTICLE 8**

### **ANNUAL DUES**

Dues may be changed by a recommendation of the Board of Trustees only and approval by two thirds (2/3) of the members present at the annual meeting. The thirty (30) day requirement does not apply to dues.

A. The amount of dues for the various classes of membership shall be:

1. Active membership- \$50.00.
3. Honorary/Life Members shall be exempt from payment of dues.

B. The dues shall cover the year March 1<sup>st</sup> to the last day in February of the following year and shall be paid on or before the first day of April.

C. Notices of said dues shall be mailed to each member by the Executive Secretary each year prior to December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the expiration of dues.

D. The Executive Secretary shall maintain an accurate roster of the membership, including mailing addresses.

E. No person shall be a member in good standing who has not paid their annual dues.

## **ARTICLE 9**

### **PARLIAMENT AUTHORITY**

Roberts Rules of Order shall be the final authority on all questions of procedure and parliamentary laws not covered by the constitution and by-laws of this association.
