

The formation of an organization was first discussed in 1975 by plumbing inspectors from the four health districts in the state of Ohio. The organization became incorporated on January 13, 1958. the first charter and founding members were Albert Zepnickel, Joseph Geissuhler, Robert A. Jennsesein and John Forbes. There have been six secretarties since that time. They were John Forbes, Matt Wainio, Fred Walker, David Petrie, Mary Butler and Dale Williamson.

In the beginning, dues were \$5.00 per year for active members, \$10.00 for associate members with both having a \$2.00 initiation fee. In November 2002, the board made the yearly dues for both active and associate members \$35.00 a year. March 2007 the body voted to increase our yearly dues to \$50.00
